- Class 6** Mini Working Hunter
Ponies not exceeding 12.2hh. Riders 12 years and under – may not compete in Class 7. (Jumps not exceeding 1’ 9”)
- Class 7** Working Hunter Pony
Not exceeding 13.2.hh (jumps not exceeding 2’ 3”)

Class 8 Working Hunter Pony
Exceeding 13.2hh but not exceeding 15hh (jumps not exceeding 2'6")

Class 9 Working Hunter
Exceeding 15.0hh (jumps not exceeding 2'9")

HORSES/PONIES ELIMINATED IN THE JUMPING PHASE WILL NOT
BE REQUIRED FOR FINAL JUDGING
WORKING HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP FOR THE ASHEY TROPHY

Class 10 Leading Rein Pony
For the **DIDDYMAN TROPHY**. Ponies not exceeding 12.2hh. Riders 8 years & under (snaffle bridles only – leading rein to be attached to the noseband). Rider may only compete on lead rein.

LUNCH BREAK

Class 11 First Ridden Pony
For the **ST. HELENS TROPHY**. Ponies not exceeding 12.2hh. Riders 12 years & under. To be ridden in any suitable bridle.

MINI CHAMPIONSHIP FOR THE YAVERLAND CUP
1st & 2nd prize winners from Classes 6, 10 & 11

Class 12 Veteran Horse or Pony 15 yrs or over - In-Hand (please display age of horse/pony)

Class 13 Child Handler – 16 yrs & under (class may be split if enough entries)

Class 14 Veteran Horse or Pony 15 yrs or over- Ridden (please display age of horse/pony)

Class 15 Ridden Competition Horse/Pony (class to be split at Judge's discretion)

RING THREE

Class 16 Handy Horse/Pony (only one entry per horse/pony)
a) In-Hand Youngstock – 3 years & under LANTERN TROPHY
b) Ridden – 4 years & over ROCKING HORSE TROPHY
c) Leading Rein – Riders 8 yrs. & under GOLDEN APPLE TROPHY

DRESSAGE ARENA

Class 17 BD Introductory Test A (2008) – Led (Riders 10 years & under)

Class 18 BD Introductory Test B (2009) – Riders never to have been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any Dressage Test

Class 19 BD Preliminary Test 4 (2002) - Combination never to have been placed 1st in any Dressage Test

Class 20 BD Preliminary Test 12 (2005) - Open

Class 21 BD Novice Test 25 (2005) - Open

Classes 17, 18 & 19 will be run between 10.30am and 12.30pm and Classes 20 & 21 from 1pm

NOTE Competitors will not be given times. The Judge will be on duty at the stated times and riders are responsible for booking a time for their test(s) with the arena steward. Entries will be restricted to 2 tests per horse/pony and on a first-come first served basis.

ENTRY FEES: £6.00 members (£7.00 non-members) per class

LATE ENTRIES OR ENTRIES OVER THE TELEPHONE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

GENERAL CONDITIONS

All Mountain & Moorland and Part-Bred Ponies must be registered with their respective Breed Society. Mountain & Moorland ponies must be shown unplaited but Part Breds may be plaited.

All ponies entered in Ring One must be owned, ridden and shown on-hand by fully paid up members of the Society

All Stallions and colts, two years or over, must have a licence, or as laid down by the respective Breed Society. Anyone riding or handling stallions or colts must wear a red armband.

All ponies in ridden classes must be 4 years old or over. No pony may be shown on a leading rein except where stated.

This show is run under the BHS Code of Practice for the Welfare of Horses and Ponies. (The full code can be downloaded from the BHS Website www.bhs.org.uk)

ALL COMPETITORS must wear correctly fitting BSI approved hats at all times when mounted. Children 16 years and under must wear hats conforming to PAS 015 or BSEN 1384 standard.

A special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Island Bred pony in all Breed classes and Part Bred classes. Handlers of ponies eligible are to wear a yellow armband.

Neither the landowner nor the organisers can be held responsible for any loss or damage, howsoever caused, to any person, animal or property whilst on the showground.

The Society reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving a reason and to ask any exhibitor behaving in a manner prejudicial to the good name of the Society to leave the showground.

Any objection to be handed to the Secretary in writing within ten minutes of the incident accompanied by a deposit of £5.00 which will be refundable if the objection is sustained.

NO SPURS ARE ALLOWED IN ANY CLASS.

Please note that classes will not be held up (except at the Judge's discretion) other than for Championships. If any classes are missed due to clashing the entry fee will be refunded in the form of a voucher which may be used for an entry at a future event. In the event of classes running late, we reserve the right to transfer classes to an unoccupied ring and use an available judge.
