- Class 6 Minimus Jumping – open to riders 12 yrs. & under (on or off the lead)

- Class 10 2'6" Jumping
- Class 11 2'9" Jumping

Combined Training £10.00 members (£12.00 non-members)

Entries for Jumping Classes will be accepted on the day at £2.00 extra per class

Each horse/pony may only be entered in 2 Dressage Classes or

Combined Training + 1 extra Dressage Class

***Each horse/pony may only be entered in 3 Jumping Classes or
Combined Training + 2 extra Jumping Classes***

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All ponies must be 4 years old or over.

No pony may be shown on a leading rein except where stated.

This event is run under the BHS Code of Practice for the Welfare of Horses and Ponies. (The full code can be downloaded from the BHS website www.bhs.org.uk)

ALL COMPETITORS must wear correctly fitting BSI approved hats at all times when mounted. Children 16 years and under must wear hats conforming to PAS 015 or BSEN 1384 standard.

Neither the landowner nor the organisers can be held responsible for any loss or damage howsoever caused to any person, animal or property whilst on the showground.

The Society reserves the right to refuse any entry or without giving a reason to ask any exhibitor behaving in a manner prejudicial to the good name of the Society to leave the showground.

Any objection to be handed to the Secretary in writing within ten minutes of the incident accompanied by a deposit of £5.00 which will be refundable if the objection is sustained.

NO SPURS ARE ALLOWED IN ANY CLASS.
