- Class 1 Novice Riding Class. Senior / Junior
*For those riders who have never been placed at any show.
No cantering.*
- Class 2. Family Horse/Pony (to be ridden by a senior and a junior)
*(A free subscription for a Family Membership for 2010/2011 will be awarded
to the winner of the Family Pony Class)*
- Class 3 Child Handler (16 years & under)
- Class 4 Ridden Pairs (open to riders on or off the leading rein)
- Class 5. Veteran Horse/Pony aged 15 years and over (In-Hand or Ridden)
Age to be displayed around animal's neck
- Class 6. Fancy Dress

N.B. **HEALTH AND SAFETY. SPECTATORS MUST NOT BLOCK
ENTRANCES / EXITS TO RINGS AND SEATS MUST STAY IN

RING TWO

Clear Round Jumping from 11am to 1pm (Entries on the day)

Mounted Games (commencing approx.1.30pm) (Entries on the day)

To be run in three sections:-

- Leading Rein (open to riders 10 yrs. & under)
- 13 years & under
- 14 yrs & over

In the event of a pony appearing to be out of control or causing a hazard, that pony will be asked to leave the ring.

RING THREE

Class 7 **Handy Pony at the Teddy Bear's Picnic** from 11am to 1pm

No Sticks to be used in this event.

Results will be awarded on fastest to slowest times of clear rounds, then times with one fault, then times with two faults etc.

A refusal will add to your time but three refusals at an obstacle counts as a fault so move on.

Missing an obstacle is a fault.

Failing an obstacle in some way (knocking down, running out, etc) is a fault.

To be run in four sections

- a) Leading Rein (open to riders 10 yrs. & under)
- b) 13 years & under
- c) 14 yrs. & over
- d) Any age (assisted) ridden or in hand.

Trophies will be awarded to **ponies owned and ridden by members of the Society** achieving the highest amount of points throughout the day. Points can be earned in all classes. The **MOLE END TROPHY** will be presented to the registered pony with the highest amount of points and the **BARBARA TAYLOR TROPHY** will be presented to the unregistered pony with the highest number of points.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ENTRY FEES: £4.00 per class - (Entries on the day £1.00 extra per class)

GAMES: £1.00 per game - all entries on the day

CLEAR ROUND: £2.00 per round - all entries on the day

PLEASE NOTE THAT THERE WILL BE NO FIRST-AID COVER AT THIS EVENT

All ponies must be 4 years old or over.

No stallions please.

No pony may be shown on a leading rein except where stated.

All competitors must wear correctly fitting BSI approved hats at all times when mounted. Children 16 years and under must wear hats conforming to PAS 015 or BSEN 1384 standard.

Neither the landowner nor the organisers can be held responsible for any loss or damage howsoever caused to any person, animal or property whilst on the showground.

The Society reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving a reason and to ask any exhibitor behaving in a manner prejudicial to the good name of the Society to leave the showground.

Any objection to be handed to the Secretary in writing within ten minutes of the incident accompanied by a deposit of £5.00 which will be refundable if the objection is sustained.

SPURS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN ANY CLASS.
