Class 2 Seniors - P.O.R. section may be ridden as a pair or solo but results will be calculated on individual points (other half of pair may be a junior)

Rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place in both classes

**Trophies:** Junior & Senior Tennyson Challenge Trophies to be awarded to the highest placed M & M members at the AGM

### **RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

All ponies must be 4 years old or over.

ALL COMPETITORS must wear correctly fitting BSI approved hats at all times when mounted. Children 16 years and under must wear hats conforming to PAS 015 or BSEN 1384 standard.

Neither the landowners nor the organisers can be held responsible for any loss or damage, howsoever caused, to any person, animal or property whilst taking part in the event.

Any objection to be handed to the Secretary in writing within ten minutes of the incident accompanied by a deposit of £5.00 which will be refunded if the objection is sustained.

Standing martingales and fixed reins are not permitted.

Whips not to exceed 75cm in length.

Spurs are not permitted.

Body protectors may be worn as desired in any phase

Fluorescent jacket and/or hi-viz strips must be worn during the P.O.R. phase.

Elimination may result from loss of record card on P.O.R., uncorrected error on P.T.V. course, excessive use of the whip, dangerous riding or abusive language.

**Please note that there will be no first-aid cover at this event**

### NOTES ON TREC

P.O.R. is the long distance ride section and for Level 1 this is about 7 miles in length. It is split into section by checkpoints.

At each checkpoint you will be told the speed you are expected to maintain for the next section (so it helps if you know what speed your horse travels at in each gait).

You carry a record card which is marked with your start time, time of arrival and departure at each checkpoint and finish time. This card is handed in at the finish.

P.T.V. is a course of simple obstacles most of which you could encounter out on a hack.

ALL of the obstacles are optional but will be numbered and must be tackled in the correct order. If you wish to miss out an obstacle please indicate to its judge as you approach it, then pass on to the next obstacle.

You get points for completing each obstacle, with bonus points for care and style.

The course has a generous time limit, but exceeding it may incur time penalties.

Some obstacles may be encountered on the P.O.R. but, as in P.T.V., may be by-passed if desired.

CONTROL OF PACES. This is a track of 150 metres which can be either circular or in a straight line along which your horse is judged on 2 counts, its fastest walk and its slowest canter.

(No marks are awarded if the horse breaks a gait)

Estimated time of event is 3 - 3 1/2 hours

Results will be put on the website ([iwmmponies.org.uk](http://iwmmponies.org.uk)) during the week following the event. Alternatively, if you want hard copies of the results please leave an SAE with the starter.

All rosettes will be delivered to the winners by the organisers.
